Covering a range of Art and Design projects – from drawing to sculpting – this course will enable you to develop your own visual language, as well as exploring and discussing others' work. This course is ideal if you are thinking of a future in the art industry.	
What are the course aims?	What can it lead to?
The course will provide you with the general skills, knowledge and understanding that underpin a variety of occupations and professions in the field of art and design.	This course will equip you with the knowledge and skills for entry into employment and further training. It will also enable you to progress to higher level qualifications such as the OCR Cambridge Technical Extended Diploma in Art and Design.
What will I study on this course?	
During the course, you will develop your skills in art and design work and you will have the opportunity to work in a range of 2D and 3D media. As well as developing your own use of visual language and presentation techniques, you will explore others' art and design work and investigate art and design professional practice.	
You can expect to be introduced to new and exciting ways of working and you will have the opportunity to work on a large scale with some projects. You will be encouraged to work creatively and, even though the course is only one year in duration, you should have fun working on the projects.	
During the latter part of the course, you will have the chance to develop a more in-depth approach to project work through a number of optional units	
Are there opportunities for trips or fieldwork?	
There is the opportunity to take part in a residential trip to London, as well as visits to local galleries and exhibitions.	
Are there any other costs?	You will need a range of materials and equipment to complete the course which can be purchased independently or from the Art department.
How will I be assessed?	What are the entry requirements?
You will be assessed by coursework assignments, which will be externally verified at the end of the course.	Evidence of a keen interest in art and design is essential. It would be desirable to have gained some GCSEs at grade D or above, or a Merit or Distinction at BTEC level 1 or equivalent level.
